2.	Practice	The 'Come n try' participants will be given a briefing before entering the track and will be allowed a single six minute session.
3.	ACCESS TO CIRCUIT

4. CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

1.	KART RETRIEVAL	
1.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit.	
1.2.	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.	
1.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by an Official and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.	
2.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS	
2.1.	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.	
2.2.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.	



PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Karting Australia Personal Accident Insurance only provides cover to participants who hold a current Karting Australia License. Non-Licensed participants in come and try days are not eligible for personal accident insurance.

APPAREL

Drivers must at all times when on the Race Track be wearing racing apparel that complies with Karting Australia rules.

This means:

- Full face Helmet with visor,
- One piece driving suit with long sleeves and trousers;
- Gloves that resist abrasion and provide full finger protection
- Closed shoes.
