

wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
Karts can be retrieved via out-grid gate
ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no
animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the
entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
