4.2.	Payment of the Entry Fee can be made by using Credit Card or Debit Card via KOMP		
5.	MINIMUM ENTRIES		
5.1.	4 is the minimum number of pre-entries which must be received for each Class and/or Division.		
5.2.	If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.		
5.3.	If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.		

3. COMPETITION

1.	FORMAT OF RACING	
1.1.	Practice	There will be one (1) Practice session of 6 Minutes held.
1.2.	Qualifying	There will be one (1) standalone Qualifying session of 5 laps at this Event. Lap 1 - Warm up lap. Lap 2 - Heat 1 grid. Lap 3 - Heat 2 grid. Lap 4 - Heat 3 grid. Lap 5 - Heat 4 grid.
1.3.	Racing	Heat 1 - All drivers' times from Qualifying Lap 2, Fastest to Pole, second fastest to second, etc. Heat 2 - All drivers' times from Qualifying Lap 3, Fastest to Pole, second fastest to second, etc. Heat 3 - All drivers' times from Qualifying Lap 4, Fastest to Pole, second fastest to second, etc. Heat 4 - All drivers' times from Qualifying Lap 5, Fastest to Pole, second fastest to second, etc. Final - Highest Points from Qualifying and Heats 1, 2, 3, 4 to Pole, second highest to second, etc.
1.4.	Point System	The Karting Australia Championship Points system will be used for this race meeting. Qualifying 2pts - Fastest overall lap time from Qualifying. Heat Races 1 st 12pts, 2 nd 10pts, 3 rd 8pts, 4 th 7pts, 5 th 6pts, 6 th 5pts, 7 th 4pts, 8 th 3pts, 9 th 2pts, 10 th to 30 th 1pt. Final 1 st 25pts, 2 nd 20pts, 3 rd 16pts, 4 th 14pts, 5 th 12pts, 6 th 10pts, 7 th 9pts, 8 th 8pts, 9 th 7pts, 10 th 6pts, 11 th 5pts, 12 th 4pts, 13 th 3pts, 14 th 2pts, 15 th to 30 th 1pt. DNS, DNF & DSQ will be awarded 0 points.
1.5.	Black Plate	A black plate will be awarded to the driver who accumulates the most points from qualifying and all five races.
1.6.	Tiebreaker	In the event of a tie, the competitor with the higher finishing position from the final will be awarded the higher overall placing.
1.7.	Full Course Yellow	Full Course Yellow will be used at this race meeting as per Competition Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 24.
1.8.	Trackside Assistance	Authorised persons to assist a driver in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 12 as outlined in the drivers' briefing notes.
2.	DISTANCES	
	Heats 1, 2, 3 & 4 - 7 Minutes + 1 Lap	Final - 15 Minutes + 1 Lap
3.	ACCESS TO CIRCUIT	
3.1.	Competitors will be given access to the track from 12:00pm Friday 8 th of September for setup only.	
3.2.	Competitors WILL NOT be given access to the track for practice from 5:00pm Sunday 3 rd of September to 9:00am Saturday 9 th of September.	
4.	DRIVERS BRIEFING	
4.1.	Drivers briefing will be held on the grassed area in front of the canteen. Any question should be directed to the Clerk of Course or Chief Steward prior to the start of Competition.	
4.2.	All competitors will receive drivers briefing notes and a race timetable prior to the commencement of the race meeting via email.	

5.	SCRUTINEERING	
5.1.	All Competitors will be required to complete a Scrutineering Declaration at the time of entry through KOMP.	
5.2.	Competitors will be required to have their engine and restrictors sealed at scrutineering with a Karting Australia issued seal prior to being used in any competition.	
5.3.	Seals can be purchased from the Tower. Previously used Karting Australia issued seals will be accepted but will still need to be taken to scrutineering prior to being used to be kept on record.	
5.4.	All D Graders licence holders must have their karts scrutineered prior to racing.	
6.	FUEL	
6.1.	PULP is the only fuel permitted to be used at this Meeting.	
6.2.	Control Fuel Will be used at this Meeting.	
6.3.	Control Fuel for use at this meeting must be purchased from: BP Service Station, Newnham 117 George Town Road, Newnham, Tasmania, 7248 BP Ultimate Unleaded 98	
6.4.	Control Fuel for this meeting can be purchased from Friday the 8 th of September 2023 onwards.	
6.5.	Proof of purchase receipts for the Fuel MUST be retained and produced to the Chief Scrutineer or Fuel Tester if required.	
6.6.	Control Fuel MUST be used from Saturday 9 th of September 2023 until the conclusion of the Meeting on Sunday the 10 th of September 2023.

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Practice, Qualifying & Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the out-grid gate only .
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.

6. TYRES

1.	TYRES
1.1.	Only the Tyres prescribed in the Karting Australia Manual for the relevant Class/Division are to be used.
1.2.	As per the Karting Australia recommendation sent to clubs on January 27 th 2023, tyres with serial number of L00824899 or higher must be used at this race meeting. This code will be required to be used by all classes using the LeCont LH03 Aus, SVB & SVC tyres.
