In the event of a tie the highest position will be determined by the highest position in the final.</p> <p>In the event of a tie placings will be determined by the highest finishing positions in the final</p> <p>Club Title trophies will be presented to 1st 2nd 3rd across each eligible class at the 3rd and final club title round.</p>
8.2	<p>Ladies E and D Grade race</p> <p>1st 2nd 3rd place medallions will be presented to the ladies in the D and E Grade performance group. This will be determined by using the 1st = 0 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd =3 points, points system with the winner having the lowest points.</p>

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course

3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the out-grid gate
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	Camping may be available by booking on the NWKC website (conditions apply) nwkc.org.au

Ladies E & D Grade Race

- a. All Senior Ladies with a E or D graded license entered in KA3 Medium and TAG R Medium will be combined into the competition group Ladies E&D (senior lower performance).
- b. Class rules for KA3 Snr Medium and TAG R Medium will apply
- c. Ladies E&D will not be on track with any other classes
- d. This Group will race 3 heats and a final as per all other divisions.
- e. Results will be determined as a competition group NOT individual classes

The NWKC Club Championships Regulation 2023

1) Formats

- a) The following Events will form part of the Championship
 - i) The NWKC Club Championship Round 1 February 4th 2023
 - ii) The NWKC Club Championship Round 2 June 24th 2023
 - iii) The NWKC Club Championship Round 3 Dec 9th 2023
- b) Each round is a one (1) day, standalone Meeting.
- c) Each round will consist of 3 heats and a Final
- d) Each heat will be random grid draw and consist of 8 laps
- e) The Final will consist of 12 laps

2) Track Availability

- a) The Circuit will be closed from Wednesday through to 8:00 am Saturday prior to the commencement of the Meeting.
 - i) With the Exception of persons authorised by the NWKC board to conduct activities required in the operations of the NWKC Venue and subsequent race meeting.
- b) Camping may be available by booking on the NWKC Website (Conditions Apply)

3) Championship Classes

- a) The following classes are eligible for NWKC Club Championships
 - Cadet 9
 - Cadet 12
 - KA3 Junior Light
 - KA3 Junior Heavy
 - KA3 Senior Light
 - KA3 Senior Medium
 - KA3 Senior Heavy
 - KA3 Tas Masters Light/Heavy
 - Tag R Light
 - Tag R Medium
 - Tag R Heavy
 - Tag 125 Championship
 - Open Performance
- b) All classes per Competition rules Chapter 7 Club Competition will be offered however ONLY the above-mentioned classes will be eligible for the Championship.

4) Championship Points

- a) Championship points will be awarded using the 401 minus 10% points system on each race
 - i) In the event of two or more drivers being equal on championship points, the driver with the most wins in the final will be higher placed, if a tie still exists the driver with the most 2nd place finishes in the final will be higher placed and so on until a result is achieved.
 - ii) DNF = Class plus 1
 - iii) DNS or DQ = 0 Points
 - iv) Points will be published on the NWKC Facebook page.
- b) Championship points will be awarded to each entrant in eligible championship class regardless of entries in that class NO MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIRED
- c) Championship trophies will ONLY be awarded to Championship classes that had 4 different drivers across the championship rounds.
- d) Championship trophies will be presented at the NWKC Awards night following Round 3 of the Championship at the NWKC
