

3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Practice, Qualifying and Racing.		
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course		
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.		
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via Out-Grid gate, or the recovery vehicle located outside the track gates next to St John Ambulance.		












4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS

3.	CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SYSTEM
3.1.	The point scoring used will be the 401 system previously used in the Tasmanian Statewide Series. $1^{st} = 401$, $2^{nd} = 361$, $3^{rd} = 325$, $4^{th} = 293$, $5^{th} = 264$, $6^{th} = 238$, $7^{th} = 215$, $8^{th} = 194$, $9^{th} = 175$, $10^{th} = 158$, $11^{th} = 143$, $12^{th} = 129$, $13^{th} = 117$, $14^{th} = 106$, $15^{th} = 96$, $16^{th} = 87$, $17^{th} = 79$, $18^{th} = 71$, $19^{th} = 64$, $20^{th} = 58$, $21^{st} = 52$, $22^{nd} = 47$, $23^{rd} = 43$, $24^{th} = 39$, $25^{th} = 35$, $26^{th} = 32$, $27^{th} = 29$, $28^{th} = 26$, $29^{th} = 24$, $30^{th} = 22$ DNF will receive the Class + 1 points placing. DNS & DSQ will all receive 0 points.
4.	WINNERS & AWARDS
4.1.	The driver with the most points will then win the STKC Club Championship for their individual Class/Division. Drivers must race a minimum of <u>two (2) Rounds</u> listed above to be eligible for the Club Championship. In the event of a tie, on points it will revert to the Driver with most 1 st place finishes, most 2 nd place finishes, and so on until a result is determined.
4.2.	For a Class/Division to be eligible it must have raced at a minimum of two (2) Round listed above.
4.3.	Trophies will be paid for 1 ^{st,} 2 nd and 3 rd place in all Classes/Divisions.
4.4.	Trophies for the STKC Club Championship will be awarded at, a later date to be confirmed.













7. KA3 TAS MASTERS

1.	KA3 TAS MASTERS
1.1.	As per Class Rules Chapter 6 - KA3 with the following additions - Age: Minimum 40 years of ages - Restrictor: 22mm IAME Type 3 in accordance with the Homologation. - Light Class/Division Minimum Weight including Driver: 165kg. - Heavy Class/Division Minimum Weight including Driver: 172kg.
