3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH			
	VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.			
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the out-grid gate <b>only</b> .			
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS			
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs,			
	no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.			
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.			
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.			
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the

1.1.	Only the Tyres prescribed in the Karting Australia Manual for the relevant Class/Division can be used.
1.2.	As per the Karting Australia recommendation, tyres with serial number of L00824899 or higher must be used at
1.2.	this race meeting.

## 7. PHIL GOSS MEMORIAL

1.	FORMAT & WEIGHT	
1.1.	At the completion of racing there will be a 21-lap memorial feature race for the KA3 Tas Masters division as per	
	the 2023 Tasmanian State Regulations.	
1.2.	Grid positions for this memorial race will be done via random draw. The order of the random draw will be done	
	in the finishing order of the KA3 Tas Masters Final. First place finisher in the KA3 Tas Masters Final will win the	
	opportunity to redraw their grid position twice if they aren't happy with what they have drawn. Second and third	
	place finishers will have the opportunity to redraw their position once. Fourth place onwards must keep the grid	
	position they draw.	
1.3.	Prior to the Memorial feature race all participants will compete in a one lap Pole Shuffle. The driver who has the	
	highest placed grid position will compete against the second highest with the winner of the one lap dash moving	
	on to compete against the third highest grid position. Example - 13th vs 12th, 13th place wins the one lap dash	
	moving on to compete against 11th place and so on. Any driver who is deemed to have jumped the start in the	
	1 v 1 pole shuffle race will <b>automatically black flagged</b> and lose that battle with the other driver moving on to the	
	next 1 v 1.	
1.4.	The first driver over the line in the 21-lap memorial feature race will be deemed the winner.	
2.	TYRES	
2.1.	All KA3 Tas Masters Drivers will have their tyres marked at the completion of Qualifying.	
2.2.	For competitors entering this Feature race, there mark tyres <u>MUST</u> be used.	
3.	COST	
3.1.	This one-off event will be <b>FREE</b> for KA3 Tas Masters competitors to compete in.
