





INTRODUCTION

STATE REGULATIONS: A set of regulations in a format designated by KA, that are consistent with the National Competition Rules ("**NCR**") and the International Sporting Code and that are specific to Competition sanctioned by the SKC (State, Zonal and Club Competition.) All, State Regulations must be promulgated by an SKC and approved by KA. Should there be a conflict between the Rules and the State Regulations, the Rules will prevail. In 2023, such approval from KA must be received prior to the first occasion on which they shall be applied. In subsequent years, such approval from KA must be received prior to 1 December for implementation in the following year."

"State Regulations may be applied to State, Zonal and Club Competition."

AUTHORITY

At a meeting of Karting Tasmania Inc. ("Karting Tas") on December 15th, 2022, it was resolved that these State Regulations be submitted to Karting Australia ("KA") for approval in accordance with the provisions of the National Competition Rules and having been approved by KA, promulgated for use in Competition in Tasmania from 1 January 2023 as permitted and specified.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1) PROCEDURE FOR PREPARING SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- a) Supplementary Regulations are to be submitted to the State Secretary a minimum of four (4) weeks prior to the commencement of the event for all Meetings.
- b) Supplementary Regulations are not permitted to be published until they are approved by Karting Tas, and a permit has been issued.

2) OFFICIALS APPOINTMENTS

- a) The responsibility for the appointment of Officials for a Meeting conducted under authority of Karting Tas is as follows:
 - i) Club Competition
 - 1. The Organising Club is responsible for arranging all Essential Officials for each Meeting.
 - a) It is the responsibility of each Club to have a pool of graded Officials from which they can appoint the minimum number of essential graded Officials required to conduct a Race Meeting that is prescribed in the Rules and these Regulations.
 - b) If a Club is unable to supply the required number of graded Officials for a Race Meeting, they must advise the State Officials Coordinator as soon as this becomes apparent to them and seek the assistance of Karting Tas to source the required Officials from another Club or Clubs.
 - 2. The Organising Club is responsible for arranging all other officials required by Karting Tas.
 - 3. The Organising Club is responsible for any agreed reimbursement of travelling and accommodation expenses of Officials that may be required.
 - ii) Zonal Competition
 - 1. The Organising Club is responsible for arranging all Essential Officials for each Meeting.
 - c) It is the responsibility of each Club to have a pool of graded Officials from which they can appoint the minimum number of essential graded Officials required to conduct a Race Meeting that is prescribed in the Rules and these Regulations.
 - d) If a Club is unable to supply the required number of graded Officials for a Race Meeting, they must advise the State Officials Coordinator as soon as this becomes apparent to them and seek the assistance of Karting Tas to source the required Officials from another Club or Clubs.
 - 2. The Organising Club is responsible for arranging all other officials required by Karting Tas.
 - 3. The Organising Club is responsible for any agreed reimbursement of travelling and accommodation expenses of Officials that may be required.
 - iii) State Series
 - 1. The State Executive is responsible for arranging all essential Officials for each Meeting.
 - 2. The Organising Club is responsible for arranging all other Officials required by Karting Tas.

3. Karting Tas will be responsible for any agreed reimbursement of travelling Officials that have been appointed by the State for each Round of the Series. After that each organising Club will be responsible for any agreed reimbursement of travelling Officials that have been supplied by the Clubs themselves, if required.

iv) Vintage Events

1. The Organising Club is responsible for arranging all Officials, not including the required Vintage Committee approved representative.

- 1) The Organising Club is responsible for any agreed reimbursement of travelling Officials if required.
- 2) Where Vintage Events are integrated as part of another Meeting, all Officials will be those as appointed by the Organising Club, with the addition of the required Vintage Committee approved representative.

3) PERMIT FEES FOR EVENTS

- a) A schedule of fees will be published and distributed to each Club by Karting Tas. All Fees are inclusive of GST, where GST is applicable and inclusive of National and State Track Development Levies.
- b) A Club is required to pay all fees invoiced within the payment terms stipulated on the Tax Invoice.
- c) An additional fee may be charged for State Series Events to cover Karting Tas expenses.

4) MINIMUM CLOSING TIME FOR ENTRIES

- a) Club Competition
 - i) Pre-entries must be submitted using the CMS/KOMP Karting Operations & Management Portal
 - ii) Entries will close a minimum of four (4) days prior to the first day of Competition. The closing of entries date will be advised in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - iii) Entries may be accepted at the Meeting at the discretion of the Organising Club (COVID-19 Regulations will apply).
- b) Zonal Competition
 - i) Pre-entries must be submitted using the CMS/KOMP
 - ii) Entries will close a minimum of four (4) days prior to the first day of Competition. The closing of entries date will be advised in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - iii) Entries will not be accepted at the Meeting.
- c) State Series
 - i) Pre-entries must be submitted using the CMS/KOMP
 - ii) Entries for each Round of the Series will close a minimum of four (4) days prior to the first day of Competition. The closing of entries date will be advised in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - iii) Entries will not be accepted at the Meeting.

5) CONSOLIDATION OF CLASSES

- a) The Organising Club may consolidate Classes and/or Divisions in accordance with the Rules to run on the track simultaneously at Zonal and Club Competition.
- b) Classes and/or Divisions in State Series and State Cup events may only be consolidated at the sole discretion of Karting Tas.
- c) If Classes and/or Divisions are consolidated, each Organising Club will be permitted to adjust the number of laps at their discretion.
- d) State Series, State Cup and Zonal Competition must be conducted in accordance with Competition Rules, Chapter 5, Rule 6, State Series, State Cup, State Trophy, Zonal Competition.
- e) Club Competition must be conducted in accordance with Competition Rules, Chapter 5, Rule 7, Club Competition.

6) LICENCE CRITERIA

- a) At Club Competition and Zonal Race Meetings, Drivers holding a Maximum of a B Grade Senior Licence who are Competing in TaG 125 Restricted Classes/Divisions will be eligible for points and awards.
- b) B Grade and above Senior Licence holders are not permitted to compete in the TaG 125 Restricted Division in State Series and State Cup Events.

7) POINTS SCORE

a) The points awarded for each Competition if they are part of a series of events or a standalone event will be determined by the Organising Club and advised in the Supplementary Regulations.

8) POINTS SCORE FOR GRID PROCEDURES

a) The point score for each State Series, State Cup Event, Zonal and Club Competition Race Meeting, must be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations.

9) NON-COMPETITIVE ACTIVITIES

- a) Non-Competitive Activities must be conducted in accordance with the Rules and these State Regulations.
- b) Non-Competitive Activities will include Bring a Mate, Come and Try Days, Organised Social Karting Activities, Club Organised Practice Days.

Organised Social Karting Activities is included in the Rules (Appendix 1 - Organised Social Karting Activity).

Club Organised Practice is included in the Rules (Appendix 3 - Private Practice Rules).

Bring a Mate and Come & Try Days are included in the Rules (Appendix 4 - Introduction to Karting).

- c) Come and Try Days and Bring a Mate sessions are permitted as either a standalone event or as part of Club Competition. If they are being conducted at a Meeting, these sessions must be included in the Supplementary Regulations for the Meeting and in the schedule.
- d) Application for an Organising Permit for a Non-Competitive Activity other than an Organised Social Karting Activity
 - (i) Seven (7) days prior to the scheduled date of commencement of the Non-Competitive Activity, the Organiser must submit to the State Secretary:
 - 1) An Application for an Organising Permit; and
 - 2) The appropriate Organising Permit fee; and
 - A copy of the proposed Supplementary Regulations for the Meeting for review and approval.
 (ii) Once the Supplementary Regulations are approved, the State Secretary will distribute to the necessary Officials and others as may be required.
- e) Application for an Organising Permit and notification of adjustment to the Officials for an Organised Social Karting Activity are in accordance with Appendix 1, Article 2 of the 2022 Australian Karting Manual and National Competition Rules.
- f) Entries for each Non-Competitive Activity must be coordinated by the Administrator of the Activity.

STATE SERIES COMPETITION - KARTING TAS STATEWIDE SERIES

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1) GENERAL

- a) These Regulations are for the Karting Tasmania Statewide Series (Series) Competitions conducted under the authority of Karting Tas.
- b) The following Events will for part of the Series:
 - i) Round 1 25th 26th February 2023
 - ii) Round 2 25th 2
 - iii) Round 3
- 25th 26th March 2023 8th - 9th July 2023
- iv) Round 4 29th 30th July 2023

Southern Tasmanian Kart Club North Western Kart Club Circular Head Kart Club Launceston Kart Club

- c) Each round is a two (2) day, standalone Meeting.
- d) It is not permitted to conduct any Competition of any type in Tasmania on the same day as a State Series Competition.
- e) A Class and/or Division must have a minimum of four (4) entries to constitute a Class and/or Division.
- f) A Class and/or Division must run at a minimum of three (3) round of the Series to be eligible for Prizes and Awards.
- g) Each Driver must have a minimum of a D Grade Licence to compete in the State Series, subject to the requirements on the relevant Class Rules.
- h) The Circuit will be closed from Midnight Monday through to 7:00am Saturday prior to the commencement of the Meeting
- i) The following Officials have been appointed for the Series:
 - i) Series Race Director: TBC
 - ii) Chief Steward: TBC
 - iii) Clerk of the Course: TBC

2) CLASSES & TYRE TYPES

a) The following Classes and/or Division must be eligible to Compete at each Round of the Series:

- b) The following Classes and/or Divisions may be consolidated to compete on track at the same time:
 - i) TaG 125 Restricted Heavy / TAS KA4 Masters
 - ii) TaG 125 Restricted Light / TaG 125 Restricted Medium

3) TYRES

- a) Only the Dry Prime and Wet Weather tyres prescribed in the Rules for the relevant Class/Division are permitted to be used.
- b) For each Class/Division other that TaG 125 Championship, the following additional requirements will apply:
 - i) From the commencement of Qualifying, each Competitor is permitted to use a maximum of one (1) set of dry weather tyres for two (2) rounds of the Series in accordance with the following:
 - Rounds 1 and 2: One (1) set of Dry Prime Tyres (plus one (1) replacement Dry Prime Tyre in accordance with the Rules); and

• Rounds 3 and 4: One (1) set of Dry - Prime Tyres, (plus one (1) replacement Dry - Prime Tyre in accordance with the Rules).

ii) Wet Weather Tyre requirements are in accordance with the respective Class Rules.

d) Each set of Tyres must remain as a set of four (4). The mixing and matching of tyres, is not permitted.

4) FRONT FAIRING RULES (Technical Rules, Chapter 8 g) (iii)

a) The Front Fairing Fitment Rules will be used at this Series.

5) SCRUTINEERING

- a) Scrutineering for this Series will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2023 Karting Australia Rule Book.
- b) In accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6, each kart shall have affixed to it the correct Scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting/Series. This signifies that the driver has confirmed their entry for the meeting and completed a Scrutineering form relevant to the entry.
- c) Scrutineering forms must be submitted no later than the date specified on the Supplementary Regulations, otherwise entry to the Meeting will be removed and non-refundable.

6) ENGINE & RESTRICTOR SEALING

a) All engines and restrictors must be sealed prior to Qualifying in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

7) TIMING TRANSPONDER FITTING

a) MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 8 i) **Note:** All karts <u>MUST</u> have a fitted and correctly charged and operating transponder for Qualifying and Racing.

8) ENTRY FEE

- a) The Entry Fee for each Round of the Series are as follows:
 - i) First Entry Fee: \$100.00 for each Class/Division
 - ii) Second and subsequent Entry Fees: \$50.00 for each Class/Division entered by the same Competitor.
 - iii)Entry Fee: all four (4) rounds of the State-wide Series for \$360.00, this to be paid at entering the first round
- b) The terms and method of payment will be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations for the Meeting. Payment <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted at the Meeting.
- c) The Entry Fee must be received to confirm a competitor's entry to the Meeting.

9) FORMAT

- a) Practice
 - i) There will be a minimum of two (2) practice sessions for each Class/Division at each Round of the Series and must be included in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - ii) Each Practice session will be six (6) minutes in duration for each Class/Division.
- b) Qualifying
 - i) There will be one (1) Qualifying session, which must be a minimum of six (6) minutes in duration for each Class/Division.
 - ii) The duration of the Qualifying session must be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - iii) The Kart order on the Out Grid for the commencement of Qualifying must be random.
 - iv) Qualifying and Racing will commence on the Saturday of the Event.
- c) Grid Procedure
 - i) Heat 1 and Heat 2: Grid positions will be in the accordance with the results of Qualifying, with the fastest Qualifier on Pole Position and so on.
 - ii) Heat 3: Grid positions will be the highest accumulated points from Race 1 and Race 2 will start on Pole Position and so on. In the event of a tie, on points it will then revert, back to the competitor with the fastest qualifying time.

- iii) Final: Grid positions will be the highest accumulated points from Heat 1, Heat 2 and Heat 3 will start on Pole Position and so on. In the event of a tie, on points it will then revert, back to the competitor with the fastest qualifying time.
- d) Race Format
 - i) Heat 1 will be 14 Laps in duration.
 - ii) Heat 2 will be 14 Laps in duration.
 - iii) Heat 3 will be 14 Laps in duration.
 - iv) Final will be 14 Laps in duration.
 - v) The distances listed above may be increased or decreased at the discretion of the Organising Club with the prior approval of Karting Tas.
- e) Round Winners

The winner of each Round of the Series will be determined by the finishing order of the final.

10) PRIZES AND AWARDS

- a) Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place in each Class/Division at each Round of the Series by the Organising Club.
- b) Karting Tas will supply the trophies for each Club for all four (4) Rounds of the Series. The Organising Clubs may award additional trophies or awards the cost of which will be borne by the Club.
- c) For each Class/Division which is consolidated to compete on the Track at the same time, points will be awarded based on finishing order of each Class/Division, not overall finishing order.
- d) Series Prizes and Awards will be supplied by Karting Tasmania and will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each Class/Division.

11) SERIES POINTS

- a) The Series point score outlined below will be used to determine the results at each Round of the Series. DNS and DSQ will receive zero (0) points and DNF will receive the Class + 1 points place
- b) These points will count towards the point score for Prizes and Awards
- c) The Series classification in each Class/Division will be determined as follows
 - i) 1st based on the highest accumulated points across all four (4) Rounds in each Class/Division.
 ii) 2nd based on the second highest accumulated points across all four (4) Rounds in each Class/Division and so on.
- d) All Points will be compiled at the end of each Series Round by the Series Points Coordinator. Any queries in regards, to points is to be directed to your Home Club's Secretary to follow up with, Karting Tas.
- e) Series Points once compiled at the end of each Round will be published on the Karting Tas and Statewide Series 2023 Facebook page and website: <u>www.kartingtas.net.au</u>

ZONAL COMPETITION

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1) GENERAL

- a) These Regulations are for Zonal Competition under the authority of Karting Tas.
- b) Zonal Competition must be approved by Karting Tas and be listed on the State Calendar.
- c) A Class/Division must have a minimum of four (4) entries to constitute a Class and/or Division. If insufficient entries are received to constitute a Class/Division, those entries/entry may be combined with another Class/Division at the discretion of the Organising Club.

2) OFFICIALS MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS - ZONAL

- a) Appointment of essential Officials will refer to Karting Australia's P25 Officials Licence Policy and in conjunction with Karting Tas.
- b) Essential Officials include Stewards, Clerk/s of Course, Timekeeper, Scrutineer, Scales Marshal, Flag Marshal, Starter and Grid Marshal
- b) All Officials must hold a current "Working with Vulnerable People check" Card.

3) CLASSES & TYRE TYPES

a) The following Classes/Division are eligible to compete in Zonal Competition:

- b) The following Classes and/or Divisions may be consolidated to compete on track at the same time: i) TaG 125 Restricted Heavy / KA4 Masters
 - ii) KA3 Senior Light / KA3 Senior Medium
 - iii) TaG 125 Restricted Light / TaG 125 Restricted Medium

4) ENTRY FEE

- a) The Entry Fee for each Zonal Competition Meeting will be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations.
- b) The terms and method of payment will be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations for the Meeting.
- c) The Entry Fee must be received to confirm a competitor's entry to the Meeting.

5) FORMAT

a) Practice

- i) The Organising Club may conduct unofficial Practice prior to the Event.
- ii) A Practice session which is part of the Meeting must be included in the Supplementary Regulations.
- iii) Classes and/or Divisions may be consolidated in accordance with the Rules to maximise the amount of track time for each Competitor.
- b) Qualifying
 - i) There will be one (1) Qualifying session, which must be a minimum of six (6) minutes in duration for each Class/Division.
 - ii) The duration of the Qualifying session must be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - iii) The Kart order on the Out Grid for the commencement of Qualifying must be random.
- c) Grid Procedure
 - i) Heat 1, Heat 2, Heat 3 and Heat 4: The Organising Club will determine the number of laps for each Heat. It is recommended that each Heat will be a Minimum of 10 Laps in duration.
 - ii) Final: The Organising Club will determine the number of Laps for the Final. It is recommended that the Final is a minimum of 15 Laps in duration.
 - iii) The following Race Formats listed below are only permitted to be used for Zonal Competition:

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1) GENERAL

- a) These Regulations are for all Club Competition conducted under the authority of Karting Tas.
- b) Each Club Competition must be approved by Karting Tas and be listed on the State Calendar.
- c) Club Competition must be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Competition Rules, Chapter 5, Rule 7 and these State Regulations.
- d) A Club Championship or Club Titles must be conducted over a Minimum of three (3) rounds.
- e) Vintage Demonstrations are to be included by Clubs as much as practicable.

2) OFFICIALS MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS - CLUB COMPETITION

- a) Appointment of essential Officials will refer to Karting Australia's P25 Officials Licence Policy and in conjunction with Karting Tas.
- b) In addition to the minimum number of Officials required under the Rules for each Club Competition conducted under the authority of Karting Tas, the following will apply:
 - i) 1 extra Steward
 - ii) 1 Assistant Clerk of Course
- c) Essential Officials include Stewards, Clerk/s of Course, Timekeeper, Scrutineer, Scales Marshal, Flag Marshal, Starter and Grid Marshal
- d) All Officials must hold a current "Working with Vulnerable People check" Card.

3) CLASSES & TYRES

- a) Each Club Competition must be conducted in Competition Groups in accordance with Competition Rules, Chapter 5, rule 7, unless track capacity is reached.
- b) All Classes/Divisions listed in the Rules must be permitted to compete Club Competition.
- d) Vintage Classes are permitted to participate in Eras only in accordance with the Rules.

4) ENTRY FEE

- a) The Entry Fee for each Meeting will be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations.
- b) Entries at the Meeting will be accepted.
- c) The terms and method of payment will be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations for the Meeting. Payment will be accepted at the Meeting.
- d) The Entry Fee must be received to confirm a competitor's entry to the Meeting.

5) FORMAT

- a) Practice
 - i) Practice sessions of 5 minutes each in duration for each Class/Division may be offered as part of the Race Meeting and must be included in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - ii) Timing of the Practice Sessions is highly recommended.
- b) Qualifying

- i) Qualifying may be offered. If Qualifying is offered, it must be stipulated in the Supplementary Regulations.
- ii) If Qualifying is offered there will be one (1) Qualifying session, which may take place as stand-alone session or be combined with a warm-up session.

c) Race Formats

- i) Race Formats 1-18 as listed in these State Regulations are the only formats permitted to be used for Club Competition, unless prior approval is given by Karting Tas
- d) Races
 - i) The Race Format for each Meeting will be confirmed in the Supplementary Regulations.
 - ii) The distance of each Heat and Final will be determined by the Organising Club and included in the Supplementary Regulations.
- e) Finishing
 - i) The winning positions in each Class, Division or Competition Group can be determined either by:
 - 1) The combined points for all Races in each Class/Division; or
 - 2) The results of the Final only.

6) PRIZES AND AWARDS

- a) Prizes and Awards for will be confirmed in the Supplementary Regulations for each Meeting.
- b) The results of the Final in each Class/Division will determine the eligibility for awards.
- c) A Certificate or other award will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each Class/Division, or as specified in Supplementary Regulations.
- d) The Organising Club will supply the trophies at their cost. The Organising Club may award additional trophies or awards the cost of which will be borne by the Organising Club.

7) POINT SCORE

- a) The points awarded for a Club Competition if, they are part of a series of events, or a standalone event will be determined by the Organising Club and must be confirmed in the Supplementary Regulations for the Meeting.
- b) For combined Classes/Divisions, points will be awarded based on the finishing order in each Class/Division, not on the overall combined finishing order.
 The Club Championship classification in each Class/Division will be based on the Drivers accumulated points in all Rounds in the Championship.
