3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.		
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via access through the Out-Grid and must return through the In-Grid/Scales area. All Karts that are recovered with the recovery vehicle (if in use) will be returned to the In-Grid/Scales area and can be collected from there.
