<b>1.3.</b>	<b>Heats &amp; Final</b>	The system of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations - <b>Zonal</b> Competition Format 2 <b>Race 1</b> - Results of Qualifying fastest to the front. <b>Race 2</b> - Results of Qualifying fastest to the front. <b>Race 3</b> - Points from finishing positions of Race 1 & 2, highest points to the front. <b>Race 4</b> - Points from finishing positions of Races 1, 2 & 3, highest points to the front. <b>Winner</b> - The winner will be the Competitor with the highest overall points from all four (4) Races. In the event of a tie-on points it will be determined by Competition Rules, Chapter 1, Rule 29 a)(ii)
<b>1.4.</b>	<b>Points System</b>	401 Less 10% points score system will be used for the Feature Classes 1 <sup>st</sup> = 401 points, 2 <sup>nd</sup> = 361 points, 3 <sup>rd</sup> = 325 points, 4 <sup>th</sup> = 293 points, 5 <sup>th</sup> = 264 points, etc. DNS & DSQ will receive zero (0) points. DNF will receive the Class + 1 points placing.

2.2.	<b>Heats &amp; Final</b>	The System of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations - Competition Format 17 <b>Heat 1</b> - Random Grid Draw. <b>Heat 2</b> - Random Grid Draw. <b>Heat 3</b> - Points from finishing positions of Heat 1 & 2, lowest points to the front. <b>Final</b> - Points from finishing positions of Heats 1, 2 & 3, lowest points to the front. <b>Winner</b> - The winner will be the first Competitor over the line in the Final for their respective Class/Division.

3.	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via access through the Out-Grid and must return through the In-Grid/Scales area. All Karts that are recovered with the recovery vehicle (if in use) will be returned to the In-Grid/Scales area and can be collected from there.
4.	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, minibikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.

1.1.	<b>RISING STAR (JUNIOR CLASSES)</b> The winner of the Rising Star will be awarded to one (1) Competitor from the Junior Classes and is not judged on race results but is based on votes gained from a panel of selected judges. The Criteria includes presentation (both driver & kart), determination and skill, how they interact with Officials, Pit Crew, and fellow Competitors over the course of the Race Meeting and is not solely based on Track activities.
1.2.	<b>UP &amp; COMING RISING STAR (CADET CLASSES)</b> The winner of the Up & Coming Rising Star will be awarded to one (1) Competitor from the Cadet 9/Cadet 12 Classes and is not judged on Race results but is based on votes gained from a panel of selected judges. The Criteria includes presentation (both Driver & Kart), determination and skill, how they interact with Officials, Pit Crew, and fellow Competitors over the course of the Race Meeting and is not solely based on Track activities.
