

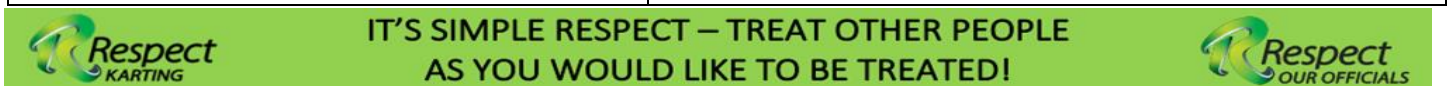

1.3	Heats & Final	The system of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations – Club Competition Format 15 for all Feature Classes .
		TaG 125 Restricted Medium, Heavy & KA3 Tas Masters
		Heat 1 (10 laps) Random Ball Draw – Draw will be done in order of entry via KOMP. Heat 2 (10 laps) Reverse Grid of Heat 1.

		Heat 3 (12 laps) Points from finishing positions of Heats 1 & 2, lowest to the front. Heat 4 (14 laps) Points from finishing positions of Heats 1, 2 & 3 highest to the front. Final (20 laps) Points from finishing positions of Heats 1, 2, 3 & 4 lowest to the front. The 0,2,3 points system will be used. DNS, DNF & DQ will be class plus 1 position. Please Note: Any competitor with two or more DNS, DNF or DQ from Heats 1, 2 or 3 will be required to start at the rear of the field for Heat 4. The system of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations – Club Competition Format 2 for all Non-Feature Classes . All Remaining Classes Heat 1 (10 Laps) Results of qualifying fastest to front. Heat 2 (10 Laps) Results of qualifying fastest to front. Heat 3 (12 Laps) Points from finishing positions of Heats 1 & 2, lowest to the front. Final (14 Laps) Points from finishing positions of Heats 1, 2, & 3, lowest to the front. The 0, 2, 3 points system will be used. DNS, DNF & DQ will be class plus 1 position.

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the out-grid gate
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	The track will be closed from Tuesday the 27 th of February to 10:00AM Saturday the 2nd of March.

5.3.	Type B Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (i.e. with a floor plan between 18 sqm and 36sq) Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting. The Structure must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules.
5.4.	Unless specifically approved by the Organiser, Type C Structures Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
5.5.	All Structures must only be erected in areas approved by the Organiser
5.6.	All Structures must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules
