3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the out-grid gate only
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, minibikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.

6. PHIL GOSS MEMORIAL

1	FORMAT & WEIGHT
1.1	At the completion of racing there will be a 21-Lap memorial feature race for the KA3 Tas Masters as per 2024 Karting Australia Manual.
1.2	Grid positions for this Memorial Race will be done via random draw. The order of the random draw will be done in the finishing order of the KA3 Masters Final. First place finisher in the KA3 Tas Masters Final will win the opportunity to redraw their grid position twice if they aren't happy with what they have drawn. Second and Third place finishers will have the opportunity to redraw their position once. Fourth place onwards must keep whichever grid position they draw.
1.3	The first driver over the line in the 21-lap memorial feature race will be deemed the winner.
2.	TYRES
2.1	All KA3 Tas Masters Drivers will have their tyres marked prior to Qualifying.
2.2	For competitors entering this Feature Race, their marked tyres MUST be used for this Race

3.1	This one-off Event will be FREE for Competitors to compete in
